#### **Congress of the Association of Canossian Laity:**

As we all know, due to the Covid 19 pandemic, the date and place of the Congress have been moved twice. In a phase of reorganization and discernment, taking into account the beginning of the Jubilee Year, on December 24, 2024 which will last until January 6, 2026, we have decided to establish the City of Rome as the venue for our Congress, so that lay participants arriving from the 5 continents can experience this event of great spiritual, ecclesial and social importance in the life of the Church.

From the above, we announce that the next International Congress of the Canossian Laity Association will be held at the House of the Canossian Daughters of Charity, in Via della Stazione di Ottavia 70 – 00135 Rome, from 12 to 20 July 2025.

For the purpose of preparing for the Congress, an ad hoc Commission will be formed. In future communications, we will deepen the organization.

### **Zoom meeting:**

With the aim of living the joy of communion to "Ignite Life in this Jubilee Year", to meet, to get to know each other and to start a process of listening in preparation for the International Congress of the Canossian Laity Association, we propose the realization of virtual meetings by languages through the ZOOM platform. We would do it in 3 groups, one in Italian and two in English.
